


- Accommodation & cost of living about 650 € per month

- Student' cities: about 40 000 students for about 300 000 inhabitants in Nancy and about 15 000 students for about 122 000 inhabitants in Metz

STUDENT LIFE

- Campuses: 262 buildings, distributed over 52 university sites.
- **Housing & catering**: In France, student housing and catering are managed by a public institution: the CROUS (Regional Centre for student support).
- Cultural life: Université de Lorraine proposes a particularly rich cultural offer, open
 to all study fields. It owns and directly manages the Theater of Saulcy, BernardMarie Koltès space, labelled as a «scene theatre of Contemporary writings» on
 the campus of the Saulcy in Metz. The university also performs events in the
 amphitheater Déléage on the Humanities campus in Nancy.
- Sport activities at the University: the SUAPS offers a pedagogic program with more
 than 70 activities from beginner to expert level (online registration:
 www.suaps.univ-lorraine.fr).
- *Libraries*: 60 libraries, 5 500 seats available, 30 000 new volumes every year 2 000 periodicals and reviews subscriptions, 7 000 students trained to desk-based research per year.
- **Health services**: Free and confidential consultations, appointments and social counselling, courses.
