Areas of study not available to Visiting students	Medicine, Gerontology, Health Care and Science.
Grading System	Grades are assigned between A+ (top mark) to F (failure). The grades are distributed from A+, A, B+, B, C+, C, D+ to F.
Number of ECTS	The number of classes the students register for depends on the requirements of the student's home institution. Visiting students at the University of Malta can register for a minimum of 8 ECTS per semester and a maximum of 30 ECTS per semester
