### **HEALTH INSURANCE**

Before leaving, be sure to make arrangements regarding health insurance. Obtain a European Certificate or a valid equivalent private international insurance of Health Insurance.

Non-EU students can get a private insurance during his registration at Tor Vergata University for the study period.

EU students can ask their home authorities for the European Health Insurance (“TEAM”) for the full Erasmus study period.

### GRADING SYSTEM OF THE INSTITUTION

**Local grade:** scale from 18 to 30

<b>30 means:</b>	30 means the highest grade, with the possibility for the student to take <u>30 cum laude</u> , which is a vote of honour for his skill. It is not very frequent but not so rare to take it either.
<b>18 means:</b>	18 is the lowest grade and indicates pass enough.
<b>&lt; 18</b>	We do not foresee the possibility of putting grades lower than 18, if the student does not reach 18 it means that he has not passed the exam.
